### Who should attend

This course is for candidates who intend to sit the Part 2 examination.

### Fee and payment

The registration fees are HK\$8,000 for non HKCOG Registered Trainees / HK\$4,000 for HKCOG Registered Trainees. The fee includes refreshments, lunch and admission to the lectures/OSCE stations *for the candidate only*. You will receive written confirmation of your registration within 14 days of receipt of your payment. **Please note that you are not guaranteed a place until you receive this confirmation.**

The registration fee for observer is HK\$300. The fee includes refreshments and admission to the lectures (**observers are NOT encouraged to ask questions and essays written by observers would NOT be marked by the examiners**). **The observers would NOT be able to observe the OSCE.**

Payment must be made by cheque made payable to "The Hong Kong College of Obstetricians and Gynaecologists." (please fax a copy of the cheque with your application). Payments from abroad should be by international bankers draft or money order **in Hong Kong Dollar**. Payment in other currencies will not be accepted.

The number of candidates registered on this course is **strictly limited to 20** and early application is therefore advised. Places may not be reserved without payment in full. You are not guaranteed a place until you receive written confirmation that you have been accepted onto the course.
